Sec. 16-19. - Permit issuance; conditions; fee.

- (a) All permits required by this article shall be issued by the city clerk. A permit fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall be paid for each permit prior to issuance, provided that in the event construction is started before a written permit is granted, no permit shall be issued except upon payment of a fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
- (b) Whenever a permit is sought pursuant to this article and the street to be cut, or which has been cut, has been paved or repaved less than five (5) years next prior to the application for the permit, at the time the excavation permit is applied for and prior to the issuance thereof, in addition to all other sums required by this article, the applicant shall pay to the city clerk a special charge of an amount calculated according to the age of the pavement, as follows: During the first twelve (12) months after completion, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00); during the second twelve (12) months, eight hundred dollars (\$800.00); during the third twelve (12) months, six hundred dollars (\$600.00); during the fourth twelve (12) months, four hundred dollars (\$400.00); during the fifth twelve (12) months, two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
- (c) As a condition for the issuance of the permit, the applicant must agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the city, its agents, its officers, and its employees from any liability to any person or entity or property resulting from any act or omission of the permittee in performing the work.
- (d) As a condition for the issuance of the permit, the applicant must agree to warrant and guarantee the material and workmanship for one (1) year after the date of completion of the excavation.
- (e) The provisions of this Section shall apply to all persons and entities alike, whether or not they are authorized by law or franchise to excavate in or under any of the streets, alleys, sidewalks, other public ways, curbs and/or gutters of the city.
- (f) All monies collected pursuant to this article shall be promptly deposited into the city's general fund.

Also cost of cuts larger than 75 square foot, shall be additional 50% of original permit per each additional 75 square foot.
