CITY OF TARRANT COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES NOVEMBER 20, 2023 TARRANT CITY HALL

The City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday November 20, 2023, at 7:00PM at City Hall.

Mayor Wayman A. Newton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM following the council work session that began at 6:00PM to discuss items on the agenda and other matters.

Tarrant City Fire Chief Patrick Bennett lead those in attendance in the invocation. City Attorney Michael Brymer lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Newton asked for a roll call. The following officials were present during the roll call:

The minutes from the November 6, 2023 regularly scheduled council meeting were presented for review and approval. After review, Councilor Threadford moved to approve the minutes from November 6, 2023 meeting as amended. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Mayor Newton called for a vote.

The yeas being four (4) and the nays being zero (0), with one (1) member not voting, the motion to approve the minutes was adopted, and the minutes for November 20, 2023, council meeting were approved.

To explain why the Mayor placed the Chief of Police on Administrative Leave on November 13, 2023, the Mayor reviewed the purposes and necessities of National Crime Information Center (NCIC) database. NCIC, a major database allowing law enforcement agencies to search for information including missing persons, stolen property, warrants, individuals on probation, U.S Secret Service protection list etc. was reviewed. There was conflict on the weekend of November 10, 2023 due to the inability of Tarrant Police Department access to NCIC, resulting in the Mayor's disciplinary action to the Chief of Police.

The Chief of Police was asked to come forward and explain why the Tarrant Police Department did not have access to NCIC.

The Chief of Police explained that removal of dispatcher from Tarrant Police Department roster eliminated their access. The dispatchers that had initial access to NCIC were no longer able to access the database due to their reassignments.

This ended the communications from the Mayor's Office.

After the Mayor spoke, Councilor Tracie Threadford provided a list of the turkey winners to all those in attendance. The winners from each of the five districts that were present and claimed their winnings. List is as follows: District 1, Debbie Dumais and Nia-Imani Carwell. District 2, Nanet Baker and Tarra Reed. District 3, Paulette Doss and Ronald Arbitelle (picked up by wife Toushi). District 4, Barry Sides (picked up by wife Marilyn) and Bonita Valdez. District 5, Allen Pilkington and Mildred Cocker (delivered by Mr. Bryant).

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF TARRANT GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2023 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2024

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant, Alabama Mayor and City Council is in need of an official General Fund Budget for period beginning October 1, 2023 and ending in September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has prepared a General Fund Budget which has been reviewed and amended by the City of Tarrant Finance Department for the said period reflecting anticipated revenue and expenditures in the amount of \$12,583,560 to be effective for the period beginning October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024; and
WHEREAS, Title 12, 43-57, Code of Alabama provides as follows:

Annual appropriates of funds for expenditures of all departments and interest on indebtedness. In all cities, the Council shall appropriate the sums necessary for the expenditures of the several City departments and for the interest on its bonded and other indebtedness, not exceeding in the aggregate within ten (10) percent of its estimated receipts, and such City Council shall not appropriate in the aggregate an amount in excess of its annual legally authorized revenue. But, nothing in this section shall prevent such cities from anticipating the revenues for the year for which such appropriation was made, or from correcting for temporary loans as provided in the applicable provisions of the sitle, or from bonding or refunding their outstanding indebtedness from appropriating anticipated revenue at any time for the current expresses of the City and

interest on the bonded and other indebtedness of the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Monday, December 4, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

That the municipal general fund budget for the City of Tarrant, Alabama, Section 1. prepared by the Mayor and submitted to the City Council is hereby approved and adopted to the extent of, but not exceeding, anticipated revenue of \$12,583,560 and for interest on its bonded and other indebtedness not exceeding in the aggregate within ten (10) percent of the estimated receipts; and

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$12,583,560 from Section 2. the General Fund for municipal expenses for the period beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024; and

That a copy of said budget is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and Section 3. incorporated into this Resolution by reference, as though set out fully herein; and

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its approval and adoption.

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant challenges public safety and that public safety is constantly evolving requiring adaptation to ensure a solid operational foundation.

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant, Alabama recognizes the need for the Tarrant Police Departments measurement and evaluations of law enforcements and policy implementations for the purpose of increased public safety, protection and decreased liability insurance costs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant, Alabama, acknowledges the overall benefits of an annual police department law enforcement and policy review for its visitants, laborers, and all citizens as identified in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant Police Department Chief and Lexicole, LLC enter into agreement subject to the terms and conditions contained in the selected services and associated fees of approximately \$10,642.75 as identified in Exhibit "B."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Monday, October 16, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

On November 2, 2023, Inspector Thomas Moore scheduled an inspection to visit the site, to verify a complaint.

On Nov 2nd, 2023, at 2:30 pm. Inspector Thomas Moore placed a 48 hrs. Notice; and took pictures of the house as a proof of violation of the City of Tarrant Municipal Code Sec. 9-17. The notice of violation was place in the yard with instructions to abate the grass within 48 hours.

On November 7, 2023, Inspector Thomas Moore, sent me an email with the pictures from the property; all together with the statement of facts.

Statement of Facts.

I visited a site at 1025 Overton Ave. to verify a complaint. The alleged complaint was found to be in violation of excessive weeds in the rear yard. This was done Nov. 2, 2023. I reported to the office, a notice was posted, and pictures were taken. I revisited the site on Nov. 7, 2023. No further action had been taken; property still consisted of excessive weeds in rear yard. I removed notice after noncompliance.

On November 7, 2023 I, Beatriz Adriana Meneses Radillo, received from Inspector Thomas Moore an email with images of 1025 Overton Ave; I printed the images and placed it in the file.

On November 7, 2023, Inspector Thomas Moore. Revisited 1025 Overton Ave., and notice the property was still in violation. Homeowner property had no taking action.

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2023, a public hearing was held before the City Council of Tarrant, Alabama, to determine whether certain properties constituted a public nuisance by reason of overgrown grass, weeds, and/or other voluntary or spontaneous growth; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate notice called for in Ordinance No. 1001 was given to the person or persons in possession of, in ownership of, or in charge or control of said property 2139 Weatherly Ave. Tarrant, AL., 35217, with respect to the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, while in regular session on Monday, December 4, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

Section 1. The properties on the list attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are hereby determined to be a nuisance by reason that the abundance of overgrown grass and/or weeds within the City is injurious to the general public health, safety, and general welfare by providing breeding grounds and shelter for rats, mice, snakes, mosquitoes, and other vermin, insects, and pests; that the height and dryness of said overgrown grass and weeds constitutes a serious fire threat or hazard; that said overgrown grass and weeds produces allergens that cause irritation to the throat, lungs, and eyes of the public; that said overgrown grass and weeds hides debris that could inflict injury on persons going upon the property; and/or that said overgrown grass and weeds are unsightly and in excess of twelve (12) inches in height.

Section 2. Said nuisance shall be abated as provided for in Ordinance No. 1001 of the City of Tarrant, Alabama.

Section 3. Those individuals abating the nuisance described herein shall render an itemized report in writing to the City Council showing the cost of removing the nuisance. Before the report is submitted to the City Council, a copy of the report shall be posted for at least five days prior thereto on or near the chamber door of the City Council, together with a notice of the time when the report shall be submitted to the City Council for confirmation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, while in regular session on Monday, December 4, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

Section 1. The properties on the list attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are hereby determined to be a nuisance by reason that the abundance of overgrown grass and/or weeds within the City is injurious to the general public health, safety, and general welfare by providing breeding grounds and shelter for rats, mice, snakes, mosquitoes, and other vermin, insects, and pests; that the height and dryness of said overgrown grass and weeds constitutes a serious fire threat or hazard; that said overgrown grass and weeds produces allergens that cause irritation to the throat, lungs, and eyes of the public; that said overgrown grass and weeds hides debris that could inflict injury on persons going upon the property; and/or that said overgrown grass and weeds are unsightly and in excess of twelve (12) inches in height.

Section 2. Said nuisance shall be abated as provided for in Ordinance No. 1001 of the City of Tarrant, Alabama.

Section 3. Those individuals abating the nuisance described herein shall render an itemized report in writing to the City Council showing the cost of removing the nuisance. Before the report is submitted to the City Council, a copy of the report shall be posted for at least five days prior thereto on or near the chamber door of the City Council, together with a notice of the time when the report shall be submitted to the City Council for confirmation.

Section 2. Said nuisance shall be abated as provided for in Ordinance No. 1001 of the City of Tarrant, Alabama.

Section 3. Those individuals abating the nuisance described herein shall render an itemized report in writing to the City Council showing the cost of removing the nuisance. Before the report is submitted to the City Council, a copy of the report shall be posted for at least five days prior thereto on or near the chamber door of the City Council, together with a notice of the time when the report shall be submitted to the City Council for confirmation.







That the City Council finds the defense of the litigation brought by Mayor Wayman Newton in his official capacity as Mayor was not authorized by the City Council and the bases of which were not provided to the council prior to the filing of this action. The Council in its fiduciary legislative duties to the city, find it in best interest of public safety, the city, to defend the actions of it duly appointed police chief until such time as the actions become in the view of the Tarrant City Council inconsistent with the City of Tarrant Council approved policies and the Duties Appointed to the Chief of Police by the City Council authorizes the expenditure of public funds for the public purpose of such defense of the Chief of Police of the City of Tarrant in his official capacity and Directs the City's financial accounting department, forthwith deliver to Scott Morro Attorney at Law of the Morrow Law the designated retainer.
