The City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday March 3, 2025, at 7:00 PM at City Hall.

Mayor Newton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM immediately following the council work session that began at 6:00PM to discuss items on the agenda and other matters.

Reverend Webb lead those in attendance in the invocation. Fire Chief Patrick Bennett, lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Next, Mayor Newton asked for a roll call. The following officials were present during the roll call:

A quorum was determined to be present at the meeting.

The minutes from February 17, 2025 regularly scheduled council meeting were presented for review and approval. For the record, Councilor Freeman asked the City Clerk if the City of Tarrant extra seal was returned. The City Clerk provided a no answer. Councilor Freeman also asked the Mayor why she cannot go into the City of Tarrant information page with the Mayor responding that he did not know why. The Mayor also wanted it to go on record that his office ordered a City of Tarrant seal after the City Clerk refused to provide him the seal after he asked for it. The City Clerk interceded and reminded the Mayor of the oath he had taken and directed the Mayor to stop the false accusations. Councilor Freeman asked the City Clerk why she cannot produce the public records request sent over six weeks. The Clerk affirmed that she cannot have any access to financial records as per the Mayors direct order. For the record, Councilor Freeman asked the Mayor why he can have access to financial information that she's been entitled to for the past few years. Again, the Mayor stated he could not have the City of Tarrant Seal because the Clerk refused him. The Clerk again referenced honesty, manipulation of videos and reminded the Mayor that the City of Tarrant Ordinances are Law in which an extra seal cannot be ordered. The yeas being five (5) and the nays being zero (0), with one (1) member not voting, the motion to approve the minutes for February 17, 2025 council meeting were approved.

The Mayor moved on to communications by announcing that on Friday March 7, 2025 from 10:00am to 3:00 pm at City Hall there will be a power bill assistance clinic in conjunction between the Mayors Office and the Community Action Agency of Northeast Alabama. Qualifications include low income, sixty or over, disability. Applicants will need picture identification cards, social security cards, current electric bills, pay stubs, lease agreements or deeds and statement of earnings. Applications process will take 15 to 20 minutes. The Mayor provided his office number with the assistance information at extension 1024. The Mayor asked all those in attendance to verbally provide information to all City of Tarrant residents who might fit the said criteria.

The Mayors Office also in conjunction with Dr. Daniel Cason will be hosting an Easter Egg event to be held on Sunday, April 13, 2025 from 11:00am to 2:00pm at the Tarrant Recreation Center. Again, the Mayor provided the City of Tarrant City Hall number 205.849.2800 with the assistant extension number at 1024. Easter egg baskets, groceries, clothing and haircuts will be some of the offered services and items provided. The first 200 kids will receive an Easter Egg basket. The Mayor asked the public to bring their children and that this event is the week before the official Easter Sunday.

The Mayor also announced that the *Rushing* Springs Baptist Church will have their annual clean up day from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm, Saturday March 8, 2025. The Mayor reminded *all those in attendance* of the historical African American cemetery located in District 5. The cemetery is with the Russian Springs Baptist Church that goes back to the 1830's, and that the last individual buried in the cemetery was in 1963. The 2024 clean up project made the cemetery accessible and the cemetery now holds an annual cemetery to ensure the continued access. The Church is located at 550 Rushing Springs Rd., Birmingham, Alabama. The Mayor reminded all those in attendance to bring their own tools including rakes, gloves, shovels, etc. No small children will be allowed. The annual maintenance of the cemetery will aid in the perseverance of African American history and the City of Tarrant history.

Councilor Threadford also provided an invitation for the City of Tarrant annual Easter Egg hunt to be held on Saturday, April 5, 2025 from 1:00pm to 3:00pm at the Tarrant Athletic Complex. Food, games and golden eggs will be some of the surprises.

There were no committee reports.

The Mayor and Council moved on to Old Business.

Mayor Wayman Newton introduced and read Resolution No. 9248. A Resolution Affirming the Termination of the Employment of Jason Rickels from the Office of Fire Chief for the City of Tarrant. For the interest of time and for personal prediction of no seconder; however, Councilor Bryant provided a second for the Resolution. Councilor Bryant provided history on hiring, firing and outcome recommendations of the Jefferson County Personnel Board. Councilor Bryant stated there was not reason enough to terminate Fire Chief Jason Rickels. Councilor Bryant also reminded the Mayor of the current financial relationship between the City of Tarrant and the Fire Chief. Councilor Bryant withdrew his motion to second. Mayor Newton asked each Council member for another second. There was no seconder. Mayor Newton asked the City Clerk to add the Resolution No. 9248 to the next City Council regular scheduled meeting.

Mayor Newton introduced Resolution No. 9263. A Resolution Approving of and Adopting the City of Tarrant Employee Handbook. Councilor Bryant moved to approve Resolution No. 9263. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Mayor Newton called for a vote.

The Mayor and Council moved on to New Business

Mayor Newton did not introduce and read Resolution No. 9264. A Resolution Removing Chief Wendell Major from the Office of Chief of Police for the City of Tarrant. The Mayor asked the City Clerk to ensure the Resolution is added to the next City Council meeting, and instead, the Mayor introduced an issue via letter regarding the Birmingham Humane Society and compared it to a City of Tarrant Police Chief and Police Department occurrence in July 2023. The Mayor read a letter from the Birmingham Human Society regarding a feline. The letter, on behalf of the Animal Care and Control Division of the Birmingham Humane Society recommended an independent investigation regarding a feline that lost its life on or about Sunday, February 2, 2025. According to an autopsy the feline died of starvation and dehydration. The Mayor recommended an independent investigation and reminded the Council of a previous dog that was saved. The Mayor reminded that the Council is the appointing authority over the Chief of Police and recommended the City hire an independent investigator. Councilor Bryant reminded all those in attendance that the City Attorneys need input and that there are City of Tarrant Animal Ordinances. The Chief of Police explained the current laws regarding animals. There was continued discussion around the incident described in the letter read by the Mayor. The Mayor stated the CEO will be in attendance at the next meeting.

Councilor Threadford introduced and read Resolution No. 9265. A Resolution Recognizing March 2025 as National Women's History Month. There was an applause for all the women throughout the Nation. Councilor Freeman moved to approve Resolution No. 9265. Councilor Threadford seconded the motion. Mayor Newton called for a vote.

Next, the City Council moved on to Public Comments.

First, Chuck Winborn. Chuck Winborn thanked Building Inspector David Casian, Chirs Muir, the Police Department and Chris Smoke for their duties with the City of Tarrant. Mr. Winborn updated the Council as a Crime Commission member by informing them of the hiring of two police

officers. Mr. Winborn also addressed a concerning social media post, and other recent criminal activities. Councilor Threadford asked the Chief of Police to provide accurate details regarding a social media post made by the Tarrant Tatter.

Second, Ms. Temple distributed handouts regarding a detailed history on her power bill for the past year. Ms. Temple elaborated on the conflict of square foot per electricity of her home and the watts used. Ms. Temple noted that she has been keeping accurate records on her electricity bill for the past seven years. A comparison of the similar trends, irregular trends and power surges was provided to the Council. Councilor Threadford assured Ms. Temple that the handouts will be forwarded to the Tarrant Electric Board.

Third, Reverend Webb. Reverend Webb asked for an update on the electric surplus. Councilor Threadford addressed Reverend Webb by explaining that the Council no longer holds the Electric portfolio and that it is now administered by an independent Electric Board. Reverend Webb also expressed concerns on past City of Tarrant Council issues.

After the public comments ended Mayor Newton moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. There was a verbal vote. Meeting adjourned at 8:21 pm.

RESOLUTION NO. 9248

**A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE TERMINATION OF THE
EMPLOYMENT OF JASON RICKELS FROM THE OFFICE OF
FIRE CHIEF FOR THE CITY OF TARRANT**

WHEREAS, Chris Patterson, resident and citizen of the City of Tarrant, present the following Resolution Affirming the Termination of the Employment of Jason Rickels From the Office of Fire Chief for the City of Tarrant, and request immediate action from the City Council of the City of Tarrant; and

WHEREAS, Jason Rickels ("Rickels") was appointed to the position of Fire Chief for the City of Tarrant in April, 2015 and remained in that position until his termination by Mayor Wayman Newton in April, 2021; and

WHEREAS, in March, 2021, Rickels was arrested in Roswell, Georgia for illegally holding a female African-American Realtor and a male African American Photographer at gun point and violently destroying professional photography equipment, following an unfounded accusation of burglary at his \$925,000 Georgia home; and

WHEREAS, according to witnesses, even though the victims had a pre-arranged appointment at the property through the First Multiple Listing Service, they were actively complying with a request to leave the property when Rickels arrived at the property, pulled a handgun and pursued them to their cars before a physical altercation took place; and

WHEREAS, the victims had received the request to leave the property less than 10 minutes prior to Rickels' arriving on scene; and

WHEREAS, prior to and following this incident, Rickels has a history of demeaning behavior and the use of verbally abusive language, particularly toward women and minorities; and

WHEREAS, due to the behavior of Rickels and his subsequent arrest, Mayor Wayman Newton terminated the employment of Jason Rickels in April, 2021 for Commission of a Criminal Offense and Conduct Unbecoming an Officer; and

WHEREAS, approximately two years after his arrest Jason Rickels chose to settle the Georgia incident with a monetary payout rather than face further criminal action; and

WHEREAS, currently the City of Council has before them a second opportunity to affirm the original termination of Jason Rickels' and reaffirm their commitment to protecting the citizens of Tarrant; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Tarrant should not have to live in fear of a racist and

misogynist Public Official that is tasked with, in this case, saving their lives and the lives of their children; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the City Council of the City of Tarrant take immediate action reaffirming the original termination of Jason Rickels due to his conduct unbecoming an officer of the City of Tarrant.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, **Alabama** while in regular session on Monday, March 17th, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Tarrant does hereby immediately affirm the original termination of Jason Rickels from the position of Fire Chief of the City of Tarrant, for conduct unbecoming an officer of the City of Tarrant. Any and all claims for payment of backpay, vacation, sick time, etc. are hereby forfeited.

**A RESOLUTION REMOVING CHIEF WENDELL MAJOR FROM
THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF
TARRANT**

WHEREAS, following the findings of an April, 2024 independent investigation into the Office of the Chief of Police of the City of Tarrant, which revealed multiple areas of serious misconduct on the part of Chief Wendell Major, the City Council of the City of Tarrant has continual declined to remove Chief Major from office;

WHEREAS, since that April, 2024 report, said misconduct has continued and/or escalated, exposing law enforcement officers, the citizens and the City of Tarrant to serious harm; and

WHEREAS, this ongoing misconduct includes: (a) continual closing of law enforcement cases preventing and/or obstructing active investigations (including cases which involve domestic and/or gun violence); (b) retaliation in violation of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; (c) allowing unauthorized personnel unsupervised access to sensitive and confidential areas of the Public Safety Building (including former employees who were terminated for misconduct), (d) hiring personnel outside the rules, policies and procedures as outlined by the Jefferson County Personnel Board and (e) approving contracts, services and/or expenditures without prior authorization.

WHEREAS, based on the findings of misconduct from the April, 2024 independent investigation and the current, ongoing misconduct and exposure to harm to law enforcement officers, citizens and the City of Tarrant, Chief Wendell Major is due to be removed from the Office of the Chief of Police of the City of Tarrant for cause.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Monday, March 17, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Tarrant does hereby immediately remove, for cause, Wendell Major from the Office of the Chief of Police for the City of Tarrant by a majority vote of those elected to the Council.

6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council or as otherwise becoming law.



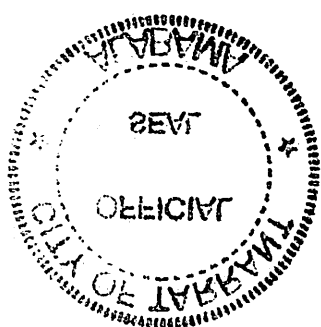
