CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TARRANT, ALABAMA RESOLUTION NO. 9264

A RESOLUTION REMOVING CHIEF WENDELL MAJOR FROM THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF TARRANT

WHEREAS, following the findings of an April, 2024 independent investigation into the Office of the Chief of Police of the City of Tarrant, which revealed multiple areas of serious misconduct on the part of Chief Wendell Major, the City Council of the City of Tarrant has continual declined to remove Chief Major from office;

WHEREAS, since that April, 2024 report, said misconduct has continued and/or escalated, exposing law enforcement officers, the citizens and the City of Tarrant to serious harm; and

WHEREAS, this ongoing misconduct includes: (a) continual closing of law enforcement cases preventing and/or obstructing active investigations (including cases which involve domestic and/or gun violence); (b) retaliation in violation of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; (c) allowing unauthorized personnel unsupervised access to sensitive and confidential areas of the Public Safety Building (including former employees who were terminated for misconduct), (d) hiring personnel outside the rules, policies and procedures as outlined by the Jefferson County Personnel Board and (e) approving contracts, services and/or expenditures without prior authorization.

WHEREAS, based on the findings of misconduct from the April, 2024 independent investigation and the current, ongoing misconduct and exposure to harm to law enforcement officers, citizens and the City of Tarrant, Chief Wendell Major is due to be removed from the Office of the Chief of Police of the City of Tarrant for cause.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Monday, August 4th, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Tarrant does hereby immediately remove, for cause, Wendell Major from the Office of the Chief of Police for the City of Tarrant by a majority vote of those elected to the Council.





WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1017 of the City of Tarrant was designed to deter and provide for the abatement of weeds and overgrown vegetation;

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2025, a public hearing was held before the City Council of Tarrant, Alabama, to determine whether certain properties constituted a public nuisance by reason of overgrown grass, weeds, and/or other voluntary or spontaneous growth; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate notice called for in Ordinance No. 1017 was given to the person or persons in possession of, in ownership of, or in charge or control of said property, with respect to the public hearing.



RESOLUTION NO. 9326

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE IMMEDIATE DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES AS ATTACHED HERETO LOCATED IN TARRANT, ALABAMA, IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTIONS 11-40-30 THROUGH 11-40-36, SECTIONS 11-53B-1 THROUGH 11-53B-16, INCLUSIVE, OF THE CODE OF ALABAMA, AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH ORDINANCE NUMBER 1022 OF THE CITY OF TARRANT, ALABAMA; AND CALLING FOR SAID DEMOLITION TO BE PERFORMED BY THE CITY OF TARRANT AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY AND THE CITY CLERK TO CAUSE THE COST OF SUCH DEMOLITION TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LAND ON WHICH THE BUILDING OR STRUCTURE EXISTS AS A MUNICIPAL LIEN OR CAUSE SUCH COST TO BE RECOVERED IN A SUIT AT LAW AGAINST THE OWNER OR OWNERS

WHEREAS, the Appropriate Municipal Official determined that the condition of the buildings and/or structures as shown on Exhibit A hereto are in such a condition as to make them dangerous to the life, health, property, morals, safety, or general welfare of the public or the occupants.

WHEREAS, contemporaneously with Finding of Public Nuisance and Declaration of Emergency, notice was sent certified mail via United States Postal Service, properly addressed and postage prepaid, to the following regarding the individual buildings and/or structures at issue:

- A. All person or persons, firm, association, or corporation last assessing the subject property for state taxes to the address on file in the Jefferson County Tax Collector's Office,
- B. The record property owner or owners (including any owner or owners of an interest in the subject property) as shown from a search of records of the office the judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama, at the owner or owners' last known address and at the address of the subject property,
- C. All mortagees of record as shown from a search of the records of the office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama, to the address set forth in the mortgage or, if no address for the mortgageee is set forth in the mortgate, to the address determined to be the correct address by the Appropriate Municipal Official,
- D. All lien holders of record as shown from a search of the records of the office of the Judge of Probate of Jefferson County, Alabama to the address set forth in the statement of lien or, if no address for the lien holder is set forth in the statement of lien, to the address determined to be the correct address by the Appropriate Municipal Official,
- E. Such other persons who are otherwise known to the Appropriate Municipal Official who could have an interest in the subject property.

WHEREAS, notice that the Appropriate Municipal Official has made a finding that the subject property is a dangerous building because it is unsafe to the extent that it is a public nuisance and is subject to demolition and that a public hearing would be held on a certain date was also given to all interested parties and to the public at large by posting at the appropriate locations.


