The City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday October 20, 2025, at 7:00 PM at City Hall.

Mayor Newton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM immediately following the council work session that began at 6:00PM to discuss items on the agenda and other matters.


Next, the City Council moved on to Public Comments.




**Section 3.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution with attestation of the clerk.


